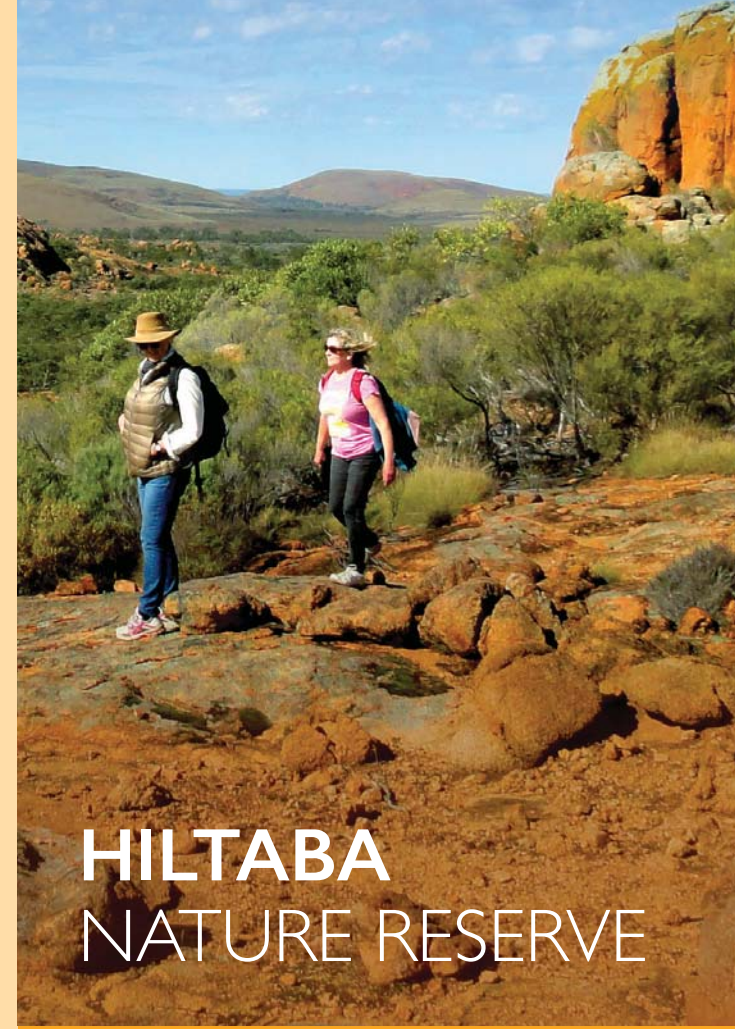

At the western end of the Gawler Ranges, the unique geological formations of this 770 square kilometre property provide habitat for species such as the Yellow-footed Rock Wallaby, the Slender-billed Thornbill and Desert Green-hood Orchid.

Hiltaba is home to more than 40 state-listed species and nine species listed for their conservation significance. For bird watchers, this is a must-see reserve, but even those without a pair of binoculars will appreciate Hiltaba's birdlife.
