Founded in 1981, Nature Foundation SA (NFSA) is a not-for-profit nature charity which works to Save, Protect and Restore land with exceptional biodiversity value and is the largest non-government conservation land owner in South Australia. NFSA focuses on the following key areas:



WATER FOR NATURE

NFSA has partnered with the Commonwealth Environmental Water Office to deliver up to 50 gegalitres of Commonwealth environmental water over five years along the River Murray in South Australia, the first agreement of this kind in the nation. Local volunteers help deliver water to multiple environmental watering sites rehabilitating wetlands and floodplains in the Riverland and the Murraylands



RESEARCH

Nature Foundation SA delivers a significant biannual research funding programme, which supports research into endangered native species with a focus on ecology and habitat restoration. To date over 300 university researchers have been awarded grants of approximately \$2 million.



BUSHBANK SA

Bushbank SA purchases properties with significant native bushland, protects them with a conservation covenant, and then sells them on to people who care about conservation.

LAND ACQUISITION & MANAGEMENT

NFSA OWNS AND MANAGES SIX NATURE RESERVES FOR CONSERVATION GAINS.



WITCHELINA

Witchelina is a 421,000 ha nature reserve located near Marree, managed by Nature Foundation SA. It is a vital part of the North-South Eco-Link which starts at Port Augusta and extends through Northern Territory into Arnhem Land.



HILTABA

Hiltaba is a 78,000 ha nature reserve located in the Gawler Ranges on the Eyre Peninsula. Managed by NFSA, Hiltaba conserves important native habitat, plants and animals and is part of the East Meets West Naturelink Corridor.



PARA WOODLANDS

Para Woodlands is a 320 ha nature reserve being managed by NFSA and DEWNR. Our aim is to re-establish critically endangered Peppermint Box grassy woodland.



TILIQUA

Tiliqua is a 85 ha nature reserve for the protection of the Pygmy Bluetongue lizards which were thought to be extinct, but rediscovered near Burra in 1992. Professor Mike Bull, Flinders University, and his researchers are conducting research at this site.



WATCHALUNGA

Watchalunga comprises 92 ha of low lying Fleurieu Peninsula Swamp at the mouth of the Finnis River. It contains a number of threatened species including the Mount Lofty Ranges Southern Emu-wren (endangered) and the Southern Bell Frog (vulnerable).



CYGNET PARK SANCTUARY

Cygnets Park Sanctuary is a 300 ha nature reserve on Kangaroo Island which has utilised the annual KI Planting Festival (organised by DEWNR) to increase habitat and biodiversity for native threatened species and plant communities.
